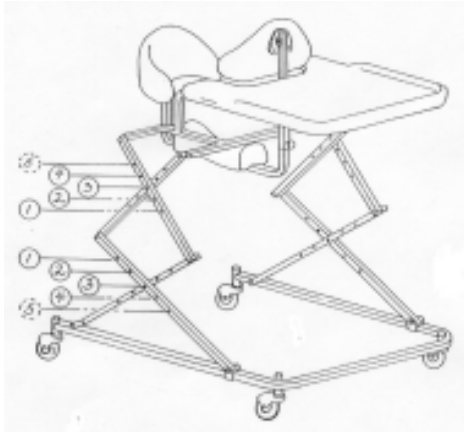


## JUNIOR POMMEL WALKER Adjustment Chart

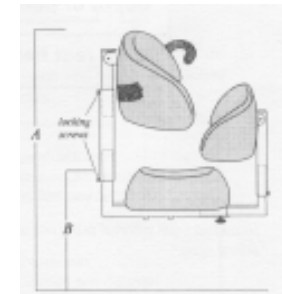
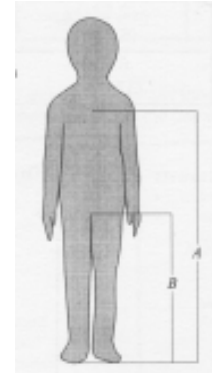


### To change to a new position:

- Lay the walker on its side on the floor.
- Remove the link bolts from both sides; extend the walker to the desired size and decide which hole the bolts will go into.
- Turn the walker onto the other side and adjust accordingly.
- Replace the nuts. Mark the holes with tape or a felt pen.

### Measurement in INCHES

Position Number	1	2	3	4
Pommel Height (B)	21.5 to 27	18.5 to 24	15.5 to 21	11.5 to 17
Tray Height	37	33.5	30.5	26.5
Chest Pad Height (front) (A)	40.5 to 46.5	37.5 to 43.5	34 to 40	30 to 36



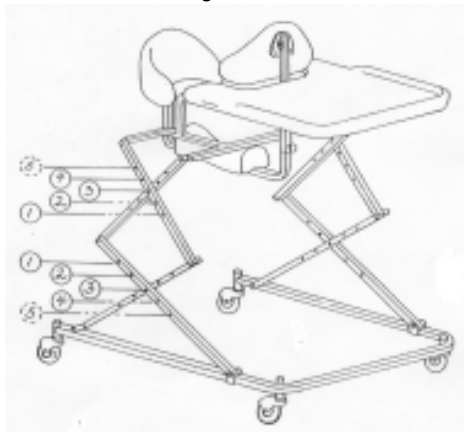
A is measurement from mid-sternum to floor

B is measurement from crotch to floor

### To adjust the pommel and chest pad height:

1. Loosen the locking screws or knobs on the front of the pommel stem (see figure at left)
2. Move the pommel and chest pad up or down to the required position.
3. Tighten the screws and knobs securely.

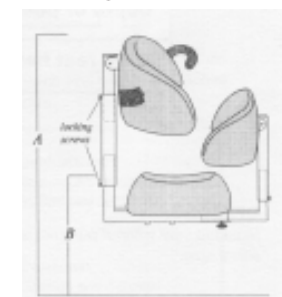
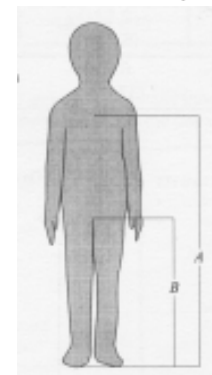
